As discussed over the phone yesterday, please find attached the MOECC letter that Ken Little of Nation Rise Wind Farm LP (Nation Rise) received on August 16, 2016 regarding consultation requirements as part of the REA.

In addition to Nation Rise receiving the attached notification letter, yourself, the Mohawk of Akwesasne and the Nation Huronne Wendat also received notification of the proposed renewable energy project. As per the MOECC letter, Nation Rise reached out to all three Aboriginal Communities.

Subsequent to the Mohawk receiving notification of the Project, they contacted Nation Rise and expressed an interest in being involved in the Stage 2 component of the project and wanted to send community members to participate in the fieldwork. After understanding the interest of the Mohawk of Akwesasne, Ken, and later me, reached out to you at AOO to gauge interest and availability in having Community Liaisons participate in the project.

The objective of Nation Rise is to be as inclusive as possible and if available, have community members from interested Aboriginal communities participate in the project as they see as appropriate. Understanding that the project study area is located within the Algonquin Settlement Boundary, Nation Rise wants to better understand any potential concerns in having the Akwesasne participate in the Stage 2 fieldwork.

The team from Nation Rise and myself are available next week to discuss any concerns that the AOO might have at a time that's suitable for you.

As requested last night, I will send through a second e-mail outlining the project, Stage 2 scope, duration and schedule for circulation to possible AOO Community Liaisons.

As requested, the following provides details regarding the project, scope and schedule for the Nation Rise Wind Farm Project for dissemination to the Community Liaisons.

**Project Description:** Nation Rise Wind Farm

**Location:** North Dundas Township, Ontario. Project is bordered to north by Marionville Road, to the west by Finch-Winchester Boundary Road, the south by Finch-Ornabruck Boundary Road and Gourville Road to the east (see attached map)

**Work Scope:** Assist with Stage 2 archaeological assessment in advance of construction. Archaeological tasks will involve working with a number of Archaeologists and walking ploughed fields at 5 metre intervals. Average day is for a crew to assess between 20 and 30 hectares.

Hello Kenneth,

It was a pleasure speaking with you on the telephone Tuesday. As promised, I'm sending you a follow-up email with some additional information.

I understand that EDP Renewables Canada Ltd. is willing to meet with the Métis Nation of Ontario (MNO) in respect of the proposed Nation Rise Wind Farm (the Project).

As mentioned, the proposed Project is located within the MNO's Region #6. A Consultation Protocol has been developed for MNO Region 6 and the document can be found on our website, [here](#).

There would likely be five or six people attending the meeting, namely, the four members of the MNO's Region 6 Consultation Committee (R6CC) plus one or two MNO support staff. MNO's R6CC consists of the MNO's Regional Councillor and one representative from each of the MNO's three Chartered Metis Community Councils located in Region #6. MNO's Chartered Community Councils within MNO's Region #6 include the Ottawa Métis Council, the High Land Waters Métis Council, and the Peterborough and District Wapiti Métis Council.



In respect of costs, the MNO requires that all costs associated with any meetings be covered by the proponent of a proposed project. Costs include travel, meals, any facility rentals, and, if an overnight stay is required, any necessary accommodations for the members of the Consultation Committee. It is MNO's best practice to work with project proponents to make every reasonable effort to minimize costs associated with consultation. Travel/meal expenses are reimbursed in accordance with the MNO's Financial Policy. The MNO's travel expense rates are equivalent to the rates of the Canadian federal government.

R6CC members are MNO political leaders that are not paid for their consultation efforts and duties. They are volunteers and serve their citizens and communities in an entirely voluntary capacity that is within their personal financial means. Thus, requests for consultations with these volunteers necessarily translate into them taking time away from work and family responsibilities in order to participate in such required consultations and related meetings. As such, and pursuant to the MNO's Financial Policy, honoraria are required for each participating member as follows:

- i) For meeting attendance, members are paid \$150.00 per meeting day;
- ii) Members are paid \$75 per travel day;
- iii) A travel and meeting day honorarium cannot be claimed for the same day, so the maximum honorarium claim per day is \$150.00; and
- iv) No part-time or full-time employee or paid representative of the MNO is entitled to an honorarium while acting in their role as an employee or paid representative of the MNO.

In respect to a meeting time(s), as R6CC members are volunteers, meeting(s) will either need to take place on a weekend or weekday evening (weekend day is preferred).

With the summer fast approaching, would you consider possible meeting dates in September? During our call, we discussed the possibility of meeting in Ottawa. If this suits you and your colleagues, I could explore the possibility of meeting at the MNO head office. However we are also open to meeting at another location.
